

PUBLIC NOTICE: 47/2024

Abaqulusi Local Municipality, South African Police Services (SAPS) and other law enforcement agencies and other relevant stakeholders have initiated the programme that aims to attend to the escalating problem of the retail stores and tuck-shops selling the goods that are not good for human consumption, whilst some are expired. The rationale is to relentlessly fight against the selling of goods that are threatening the health and lives of the consumers. Consequently, the retail and tuck shops implicated will be closed during the process of validating their status in accordance with Business Act 71 of 1991 and By Laws that governs businesses or trade licenses' requirements within the Municipal jurisdiction. Planning and Development Department (Local Economic Development-LED) Unit will have to investigate each case and advise once concluded.
